This letter is to inform you that at its meeting held on Friday, September 16, 2011 the Strafford Metropolitan Planning Organization (SMPO) Policy Committee approved Amendment #3 to the SMPO's 2011-2014 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The amendments made were shown in the attached legal notice that was published in Foster's newspaper, at the Rochester and Dover Public Libraries, and on the SRPC/SMPO website: www.strafford.org.

TIP Amendment #3 was approved following the appropriate public notice, a 30-day comment period that started on August 15, 2011 and ended on September 15, 2011, and public hearing held on September 16, 2011 as required for a full TIP amendment by our Prospectus.

In consultation with NHDOT, NHDES, USEPA, FHWA, FTA, and the other NH MPOs, Strafford Metropolitan Planning Commission has confirmed that the changes made by the proposed Amendment #3 to the adopted NHDOT 2011-2014 S/TIP do not affect the existing and approved air quality conformity analysis for the Strafford Region.

The SMPO Policy Committee approved TIP Amendment #3. This action taken by the Policy Committee officially amends the SMPO 2011-2014 TIP to incorporate the changes indicated.
